
PRODUCT PROFILE + HS CODE

Honey is an important nutritive food containing various kinds of sugar, protein, free amino acids, minerals, trace elements, enzymes and vitamins with a fairly high caloric value. Its main sugars - laevulose and dextrose are absorbed directly into the blood and provide rapid energy. Around 400,000 colonies producing more than 10,000 metric ton honey annually. Four species of honeybees are found in Pakistan. Three are indigenous and one is imported and established in Pakistan. These species are present in different ecological areas of the country. The indigenous species are Apis dorsata, Apis cerana, and Apis florea. The occidental species is Apis mellifera. Honey Production is proposed to be located at areas where wild plantation and crop farming is common.

PRODUTION AREAS

- In Punjab: Chakwal, Gujarkhan, Attock, Sargodha, Duska are ideal places for honeybee farming
- In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Karak, Kohat, Swat and Bannu are the most suitable places.
- In Province Balochistan: Quetta, Ziarat Valley, Naseerabad, and Kallat.
- In Sindh a few areas such as Thatta, Sujawal, Mirpur Khas, Hyderabad and Gularchi area are suitable for honey production.



VARIETIES

The following are the main varieties of Honey in the country,

- · Sidr (Beri or Ziziphus) which is harvested in October
- · Acacia and Orange are regarded the best in the world.
- Berri plant is a wild species found in Kohat, Chakwal, Tala Gang, Mianwali, Bannu, Nizampur and Dhadhra etc.



PRODUCTION

Beekeeping is a profitable business in Pakistan. About 7,000 beekeepers are now rearing exotic species, Apis mellifera in the modern beehives. There are about 300,000 colonies producing 7,500 metric ton honey annually.

Honey is usually packed in plastic containers and bottles but some brands are using elegant glass bottles as well.








